

If you have Vista or Windows 7 In IE

1. To run the demo version of **Arabic School Software ONLINE**, follow these instructions below:-
2. Close all browser windows. There should be no websites open.
3. Open Internet Explorer (Click on ).
4. Type **arabicsp.com** in the address bar and hit the 'Enter' key.
5. Click on Tools, On the menu bar or in the upper right corner. A menu will open.
6. Click on Internet Options (the last menu item). The Internet Options window will open.
7. Click on the Security tab (second one). The security settings will be displayed:
8. Click on the Green Checkmark, Trusted Sites.

Confirm that there is NOT a checkmark next to 'Enable Protected Mode' near the bottom of the Internet Options window. If there is a checkmark REMOVE it by clicking it.

9. Click on the Sites button below the box that has the green checkmark. A dialog box will open.
10. REMOVE the checkmark near the bottom next to "Require server verification..." by clicking it.
11. Click the Add button near the top.

That box should now be empty, and our site should be in the Websites box:

12. Also, add **www.adobe.com** to the trusted sites , type **www.adobe.com** in the 'Add this website to the zone:' box and click the Add button. It should now look similar to the following:

13. Click Close on this dialog box: and OK on Internet Options

TO run the download version or CD ROM follow these instructions:

you need to run the application to Always Run as an Administrator!

To mark an application to always run as an administrator, do the following:

1. On the Start menu, locate the program that you want to always run as an administrator.
2. Right-click the application's shortcut, and then click Properties.
3. In the Properties dialog box, click the Compatibility tab.
4. Do one of the following:
 - * To apply the setting to the currently logged-on user, select the Run This Program As An Administrator check box, and then click OK.
 - * To apply the setting to all users on the computer and regardless of which shortcut is used to start the application, click Change Setting For All Users to display the Properties dialog box for the application's .exe file, select the Run This Program As An Administrator check box, and then click OK twice.

The application will now always run using an administrator access token.
